

Some of the Main Course of International of Law

International Law

The Purpose of this course aims to introduce students the principles of international law, as well as the new developments, such as universal jurisdiction, the international criminal law, and so on. Central attention is given to the implementation and application of international law, as well as the dispute settlement. During the course, the students are encouraged to read cases and materials provided by the course convener.

International Economic Law

International economic law is a field of international law that regulates the behavior of states, international organizations and firms operating in the international arena. International economic law, as a sub-discipline of international law, subsumes the following fields: International trade law; International business regulation; International investment law; International business regulation; International intellectual property law; International finance law; International tax law; the legal system of international economic dispute settlement, such as the international commercial arbitration, the WTO dispute settlement mechanism, and the settlement of investment disputes between a state and nationals of other states.

Private International Law

The course of Private International Law focuses on the applicable law of civil and commercial legal matters concerning foreign elements. The content of course consists of four parts: the fundamental mechanisms of conflict of laws, the applicable law of several catalogues of foreign-related legal matters, China's statutes and judicial practice of Private International Law, and the international uniform legislation on conflict of laws.

WTO Law

The purpose of this course aims to introduce students the substantive rules and dispute settlement processes of the World Trade Organization (WTO). It looks at the institutions and rules of the WTO by applying a multidisciplinary perspective. Central attention is given to the rules of the WTO and how they are implemented under the dispute settlement. The teaching style is about learning through using questions as well as case studies and building on discussion. Students are encouraged to read materials, relying on the reference provided by the course

convener.

International Investment Law

International investment law course focuses on the transactions between the investors of one country and the companies or governments which receive the funds in another country. This course also researches on rules and guidelines which encourage investment and global trade between countries.

The law of international intellectual property rights

The international law of intellectual property is an important legal department of Modern international law, the contents including: the basic principles of international coordination of intellectual property system, the treaty system, organizational norms, minimum protection standards and dispute settlement mechanisms.
